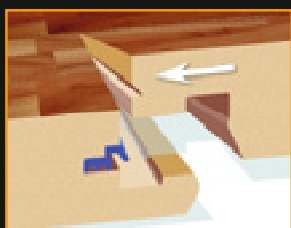

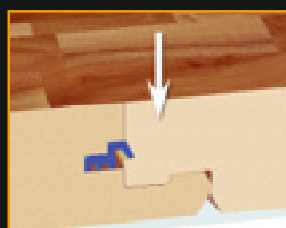

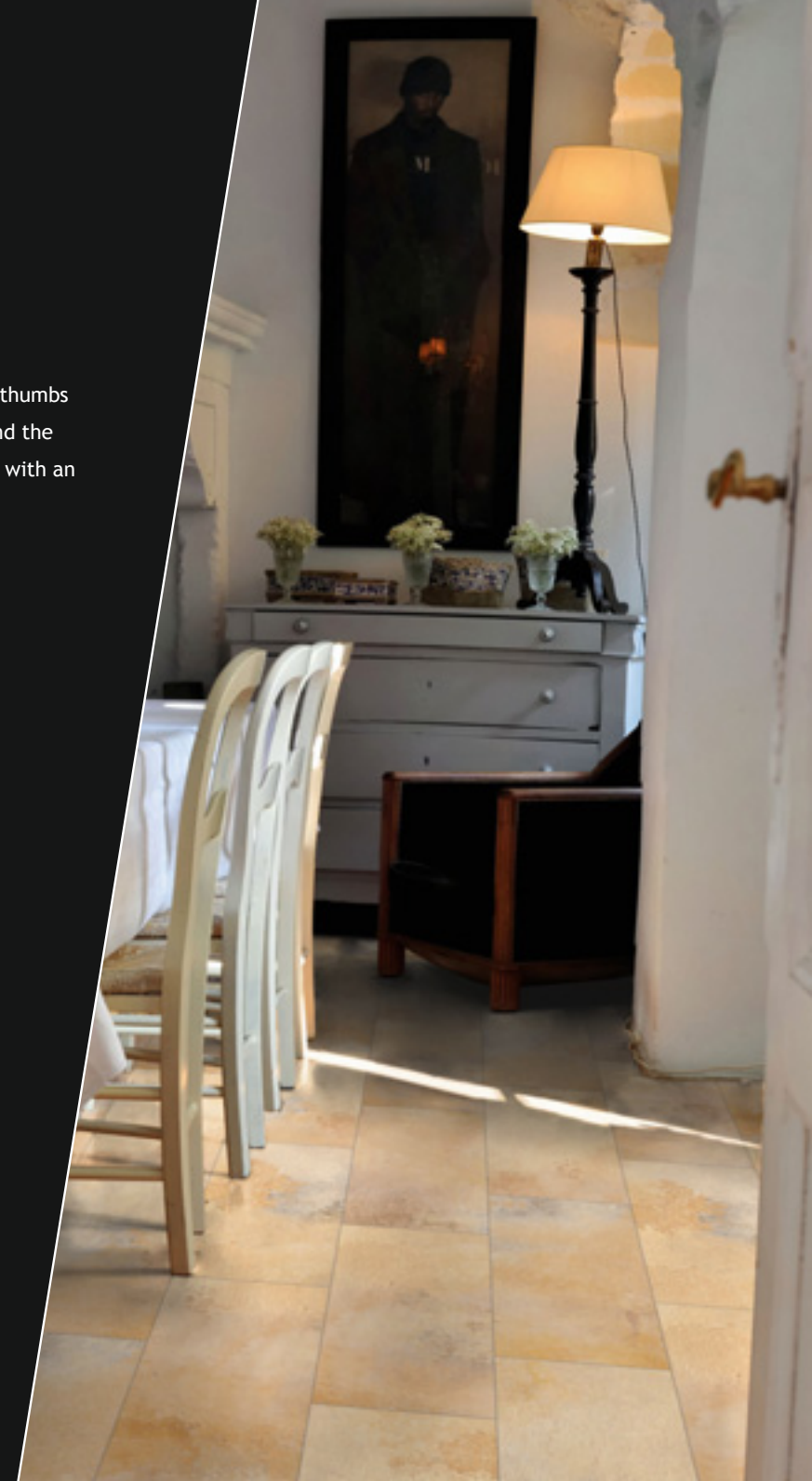

Stone [antique]

The antique decors are based on the types of stone found in Devon from the Cretaceous period. As early as Roman times and in the middle ages, this stone was used to build villas, temples, monasteries, churches, impressive castles and cathedrals - thus ANTIQUE.

Bluestone

Aachen bluestone is a very dense and thus stable limestone from the Aachen region which gets its play of colours from black with blue-green from fossil deposits in the Devon sea.

Other fossil inclusions give the Belgian granite its multi-colour appearance a homogeneous texture.

Sandstone

Sandstone is can be found almost anywhere in the world and its appearance depends on the region. Its most distinctive form can be found in the rocks of the Elb sandstone mountains. The light decor models on freshly broken Donzdorf sandstone known as iron sandstone due to its iron content. The Ulm Münster church is one of the prominent buildings made of this stone.

Maulbronn sandstone can be identified by its numerous red shadows, partly with a flame effect. It was used as early as the 12th century to build walls, stairs and floors in the Maulbronn Romanic monastery as well as for the masonry work.

Stone

A mineral substance which has materialised in the course of the history of the world as a result of hardening or metamorphosis and having a virtually infinite range of colours and structures.

Lavastone

Our lavastone decor shows magmatic rock, which has been given a slightly porous texture as a result of oxygen occlusions. This means that the lighter visio-grand decor shows basic rock with a large proportion of feldspar and quartz. The dark lavastone gets its colouring from its predominating magnesium and iron content.

Basalt

This rock-hard volcanic rock consists of thin lava or massive pyroclast was formed millions of years ago. Basalt rock has been added to the visio-grande range of decor in unusual but nonetheless classier white and the typical grey hues.

Granite

Granite is an extremely hard and very dense plutonic rock crystallised by magma slowly cooled in the Earth's crust. Occlusions of feldspar and mica give this stone its unique brilliance.

Stone

Marble and slate belong to the metamorphic rock types transformed under high pressure and at extremely high temperatures below the surface of the Earth.

Marble

Originates from limestone. Limestone is transformed into crystalline marble. At visiogrande the classical light marble as well as the dark Spanish limestone Nero Marquina Pate to produce exceptionally classy decorative effects.

Slate

Slate is a split rock, created at high pressure from sedimentary rocks. Consequently, new parallel layer silicates - mostly mica - also known colloquially as yellow mica were formed from argillaceous slate as a result. This gives rise to the stone being easy to split. The decorative slates are available in three expressive colours in the visiogrande collection.

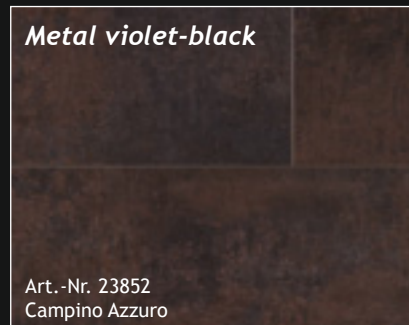
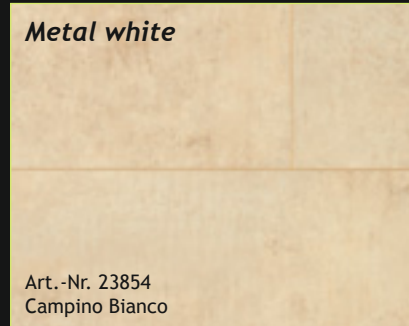

Metal

A natural resource which reflects light on its surface. Its opacity makes pure, untreated metal appear black-lilac at first. The natural alloy affects the colouration as we know from precious metals. This can be seen from visiogrande in a fine white metal decor. The visiogrande metal decors are particularly attractive when their patina is empathised. The floor then lights in a plethora of red and blue tones.
